



OBJECTIVES

1.

Manage the development of the competencies, awareness, organizational culture and commitment of judicial officers, contractors, interns and judicants to contribute to generating public value in justice administration, within the framework of compliance with applicable requirements and ethical behavior.

2.

Ensure compliance with institutional objectives, applicable regulations, improvement of the SIGCMA and user satisfaction, by reviewing the management planning on a continuous and systematic basis and strengthening risk management and its controls.

3.

Promote transparency and participation by generating guidelines and promoting accountability, consultation, reporting and raising concerns in relation to decisions and aspects of the SIGCMA.



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4.

Make rational use of natural resources by applying the principles and phases of the Circular Economy, to prevent, mitigate and control environmental impacts.

5.

Generate safe and healthy work spaces that contribute to minimizing incidents, accidents and occupational diseases derived from unsafe conditions and acts, and promote self-care, lifestyles and healthy work in judicial officers, contractors, judicants and interns.

6.

Protect, preserve and manage information assets by implementing actions to properly manage incidents, protect personal data and adopt cybersecurity and business continuity mechanisms.
